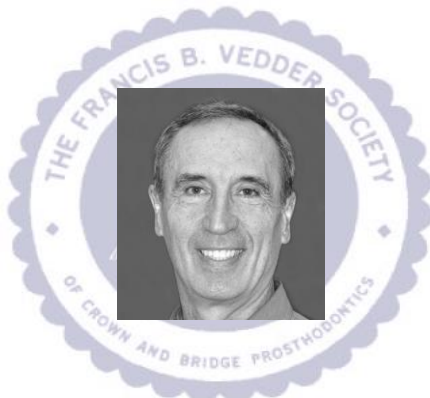

4. Communicate and remain involved with the laboratory for accurate color, contours and smile line enhancement.
5. Develop soft tissue to maximize the esthetic potential of dental implants.
